Officials approve borrowing to pay Market Street work

Hoopeston officials approved borrowing \$50,000 from landfill funds paid to the city to pay off the North Market Street project.

Alderman Jeff Johnson, street/alley committee chairman, said borrowing the money will allow the city to finish paying for the work, done earlier this vear.

The loan is expected to be repaid to the fund by spring, using Motor Fuel Tax money, Johnson said.
