Hoopeston Area to host annual Veterans Day remembrance

Veterans and guests are invited Thursday to the Hoopeston Area Middle School gymnasium for the annual Veterans Day service.

The event will begin at 9:30 a.m. with a welcome from high school Principal Larry Maynard, followed by the presentation of the colors by Hoopeston VFW and American Legion posts.

The middle school student council will lead guests in the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the high school band and chorus singing the National Anthem.

Maya Clemmons will then present the History of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. She will be followed by

guest speaker Technical Sgt. Stephen Summers of the U.S. Air Force.

The high school band will perform "In Honor of the Fallen" before Mayor Bill Crusinberry introducing recognition of all veterans present.

The high school band and chorus will perform again, with their rendition of "A Salute to American Heroes," followed by Rich Stipp reading a speech given by President Ronald Reagan.
