I Sing the Body Electric artwork at Hoopeston Public Library

Students' artwork expressing health concerns is on display at Hoopeston Public Library until November 20.

The display is part of *I Sing the Body Electric*, a three-phase arts and health education/prevention program. The exhibit is designed to promote the goal of creating healthier, happier youth who are learning the importance of making good decisions.

In the first phase, students take a health survey. The 2008 data indicated that students' top five health concerns were alcohol, teen sexuality, body image, drugs and depression. Students have the opportunity to apply for a mini-grant to create an art project for the second phase.

Based on one or more of the top five health concerns and designed to express a positive health and prevention message, these projects are judged at an Arts & Health Festival, with winners receiving cash prizes.

The display at the library is part of the third phase, where projects are taken to various sites. More than
