

Committee to look at limiting number of dogs per house

Alderwoman Sue Comstock wants to consider limiting the number of dogs Hoopeston residents may have.

At Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting, Comstock said she wants to have a civic improvement committee meeting sometime after Christmas to discuss the idea after she received" several people comment about people having five, six, seven, eight dogs on their property."

In other discussion. Alderman Jeff Johnson told the council that streets in the Prairie Meadows housing development have cracked and will have to be fixed by the developer.

Johnson hypothesized that cracks may have come be-



cause dry weather sucked water from the concrete, causing it to dry too quickly or because rebar was not used. Before the street plan was approved by the council, Johnson lobbied for using rebar but was overruled because neither city ordinance nor industry standards call for it in residential areas.
