# Hoopeston Area school officials discuss snow day policies

Monday night's tornado watch is unusual for November. Sooner or later, it's bound to snow, perhaps even enough to warrant a snow day from school.

At last week's Hoopeston Area School Board meeting, officials reviewed how parents will be notified if school is canceled before it starts or if a cancellation must occur during the school day.

If school is to be dismissed early due to snow, radio and television stations will be notified one hour before dismissal. On days when school is cancelled, media will be notified as soon as the decision is made.

Media that will be notified include radio stations

WHPO, WDAN and WITY, Danville; WGFA in Watseka and WIBN in Oxford, Ind., and television channels 3 and 15.

Parents are asked to discuss with their children the procedure children are to follow in case of an early dismissal. Some schools, such as Honeywell and John Greer, keep the information on file to be used when school is dismissed early.

Additionally, parents are asked to make sure their children are dressed appropriately for winter weather, with coats, hats and mittens or gloves
