## Rossville Dollar General store set to open January 10

ROSSVILLE—Rossville's newest store is set to open early next year.

Dollar General plans to open January 10, 2011, said Mayor Terry Prillaman, at Monday's Rossville Village Board meeting. An official ribbon cutting will be held later in the month.

In other business, the board:


- Welcomed police Chief Bill Shannon back after an eight-month absence due to a stroke.
- Approved annual safety awards of \$100 for fulltime employees and \$50 for part time employees.
- Approved a request by Trustee Dick Queen, president of Rossville Community Organization, to use the village-owned lift at no charge to remove Christmas decorations in Christman Park. RCO must complete an application and \$1 million certificate of insurance.

Queen was sanctioned for using the lift and village employees to install lights in the park district without authorization from the village. He apologized for the incident, telling the board he thought the village owned the park district. Prillaman told Queen the park district has been a separate taxing body since 1945.

- Discussed a proposed ordinance that would have prohibited parking on sidewalks and curbs. The issue died for lack of a motion.
- Took no action after discussion on parking around Rossville-Alvin Grade School on Benton and Green streets. It was suggested that teachers parallel park in the area, as they had years ago, thereby no blocking sidewalks.
- Approved the 2011 holiday schedule with 10 holidays.
- Learned the village will seek bids in January for a February opening on the South Summit water main extension.
