In other business, the council:

• Heard from Comstock that a civic improvement committee meeting will be held at 6 p.m. January 13 to discuss unresolved issues such as rummage sales and the number of dogs a person may have.

• Commended city workers for their dedication during the Christmas Eve snowstorm. Crews worked from about 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Christmas Day, then came out again Christmas afternoon.
