# HRHC receives digital mammography 3-year accreditation

Recently Hoopeston Regional Health Center acquired the technology to perform digital mammograms. With this new technology mammograms performed at Hoopeston Regional Health Center are faster and provide a more accurate picture. Results are received quickly so that the patient has the peace of mind that they will be given the best care possible.

In order to truly get the best care out of a digital mammogram, however, a facility needs to be accredited by the American College of Radiology (ACR) in Breast Imaging. After an extensive review, the HRHC Radiology Team was recently awarded a three-year term of

accreditation in mammography by the ACR.

The ACR gold seal of accreditation represents the highest level of image quality and patient safety. It is awarded only to facilities meeting ACR Practice Guidelines and Technical Standards after a peer-review evaluation by board-certified physicians and medical physicists who are experts in the field. Image quality, personnel qualifications, adequacy of facility equipment, quality control procedures, and quality assurance programs are assessed. The findings are reported to the ACR Committee on Accreditation, which subsequently
