Doors will open at 1:45 p.m. for sign in. All those auditioning must participate in a simple, mandatory dance audition offered only once, at 2:15 p.m. Those 12 and younger will also participate in a group vocal audition and will be dismissed at approximately 3:5 p.m. Parents must be present the entire time and must complete and sign an audition form for their

child.

Private individual vocal auditions for those 13 and older will begin immediately following the group vocal audition.

Those wishing to audition are asked to bring shoes to dance in and sheet music for vocal auditions—32 bars in standard musical theater style (no tapes or CDs). Candidates are asked to bring their complete calendar with all conflicts listed through August, as the information must be included on the audition form.

For those cast in *Joseph*, a \$15 insurance fee will be due at the first rehearsal in March.

ART will present *Joseph* August 6 and 7 at the Lorraine Theatre in downtown Hoopeston. The production will be directed by Kathleen Margevich.

The cast will include 12 women's roles, 14 men and a children's chorus. Male solos will include a country style soloist, Elvis impersonator, 1920s, calypso and French style singers.

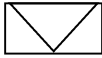

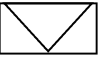
