"A key aspect of Mike's new regional duties will be leading both PCMC and PUSMC through the opportunities and challenges that will come about with Health Reform, including optimizing the synergies between our Urbana and Danville physician relationships and our clinical offerings," said Jon "Cody" Sokolski, chairman of Provena's board of directors.
