



Paxton informational meeting to focus on industrial wind developments

Energize Illinois, an energy policy group, will host an informational meeting at 6:30 p.m. March 31 at the Paxton Civic Center regarding wind farms and industrial wind development coming to Iroquois and Ford counties.

A documentary produced by area resident Rich Porter will be shown, detailing the effect of wind development on residents from Wisconsin and Illinois and explaining how the industry works. The film will be followed by a questions and answers. The public, including those who do not live near wind turbines, are encouraged to attend to learn how wind development could impact taxes and electric bills.

"In other states, electric companies have demanded

large increases in infrastructure charges to offset wind farm costs," Porter said. "As long as our utilities in Illinois are forced to purchase wind power, we are under the same dark cloud of rising costs."

Other concerns are impact on property values and lost farm ground. "Wind companies are asking the taxpayer to foot the bill for a system that doesn't work and they are paying farmers to take some of our most productive

ground out of production for decades, just when food shortages and the ethanol push have created the perfect storm on consumer prices," Porter said.
