

Cultra concerned over stray Cat

An announcement last week that Caterpillar may leave the state because of high taxes is cause for concern for state Sen. Shane Cultra (R-Onarga). "Cat provides thousands of direct and indirect jobs in the 53rd District," he said. "This move could cost Illinois over 20,000 jobs. We should not be having discussions about how to simply keep Cat in Illinois; we ought to be asking ourselves how we get them to bring more jobs back to Illinois."

Caterpillar CEO Doug Oberhelman sent a letter to Gov. Pat Quinn saying the company is considering leaving due to the tax rate hike imposed by the state. Four states, including neighboring Indiana, are courting the company.

Quinn, who is expected to meet with Oberhelman on April 5, said Saturday that Caterpillar will not leave Illinois.
