Bill Donahue, a member of the board's Structural Safety Committee and assistant state's attorney for the board, will be at the Grant Township Building, 525 S. Market, at 10 a.m. Friday. At 1:30 p.m., he will be at the conference room at the Rossville Fire Station north of Rossville.

At both locations, Donahue will take comments on the proposed wind farms, which he will present at a public

hearing to be held at 6 p.m. April 12 in the county board chambers in the Vermilion County Annex Building, 6 N. Vermilion.

Donahue will accept written or oral statements, which will be presented to the committee prior to the public hearing.

His appearances are a convenience to those who prefer not to travel to the public hearing.

Rossville voters approve reactivation ballot measure

ROSSVILLE—By a 353-296 margin, voters on Tuesday approved a measure that could lead to reactivation of the Rossville-Alvin High School.

With the total, currently unofficial, voters give the school board permission to possibly reactivate the school and stop sending students to Hoopeston Area and Bismarck-Henning high schools.

Voters approved deactivating in 2005; students began attending those schools in 2006.

While the board may do those things, they are not obligated to do so because the referendum is nonbinding.
