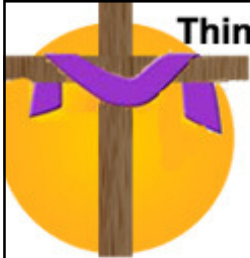

Spring issues addressed by Hoopeston council meeting

Cleanup and other springtime issues dominated Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

Alderman Carl Ankenbrand, parks committee chairman, said Sun Seeker Pools, of Michigan, was hired to repair the city swimming pool. He said caulk was removed from the liner, allowing water to get behind the liner, causing it to bow. A second issue was found on the pool floor and repaired. Total cost for the repairs was \$3,500.

On a good note, Ankenbrand said Sun Seeker workers said for its age, the pool is in good shape. Most liners are good for 12-15 years, while the local pool has had the same liner for 18 years.

In other discussion:

- Ankenbrand wondered how many properties mowed by the city are owned by the city and how many are not.
- Mayor Bill Crusinberry responded that owners are sent bills when city workers mow private property.
- Ankenbrand said the Girl Scout House roof is leaking at the flashing around the fireplace.
- On a question from Ankenbrand, Alderwoman Susan Comstock talked about a house on Penn, which has a hole in the roof. She said she has tried to find a program to pay for repairs but occupants of the house will not

allow anyone inside. Comstock will contact the county health department for possible remedies, including possible elder abuse allegations.

• Heard from Comstock that bids are still being accepted on two lots on McCracken until Monday.

• Discussed livestock ordinances after Comstock said she received requests from residents wanting to raise chickens. Crusinberry said he has received similar requests.

• Approved a \$54.87 bid from Farming with Flowers for 185 live and artificial perpetual care cemetery decorations.

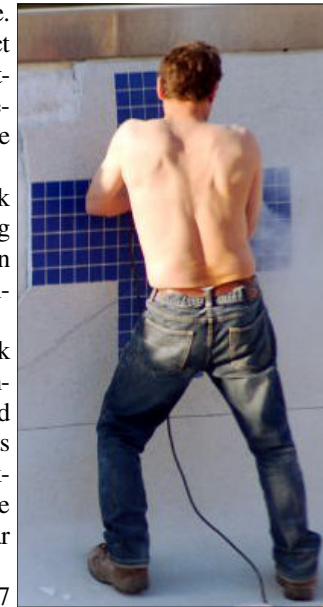

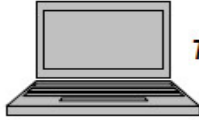
