Truck, tractor pull provides funds for local scholarships

Rossville Jaycees' annual truck and tractor pull is helping local students attend college.

At Thursday's Hoopeston Area School Board meeting, Robert Danner, representing the Rossville Jaycees, presented a check for \$5,478.98 to high school principal Larry Maynard.

In the last four years, the Jaycees have donated nearly \$20,000 in scholarship money, Danner said. The money is given to FFA students who meet academic and financial requirements and who also work at the tractor pull, he said.

This year's pull will be held August 12, Danner said, adding the event has been named a national level pull.



In unrelated business, the board heard from Ray Rice, representing a group of Rossville residents who believe Rossville-Alvin should consolidate with Hoopeston Area and Bismarck-Henning.

Rice said the recent vote on possibly reactivating Ross-

ville's high school, is "backtracking," and he urged the board to "quit giving...sweetheart deals" to Rossville-Alvin. The district has neither the money nor number of students for programs offered at either Hoopeston Area or Bismarck-Henning "but they seem to want to try," he said.

Saying the relationship between Rossville-Alvin and Bismarck-Henning seems to have soured, Rice said he hoped the same didn't happen with Hoopeston.

In other business, the board approved high school roof repairs totaling more than \$106,000. Repairs will be done to the areas over the auditorium, wood shop and biology areas, said Superintendent Hank Hornbeck.

Also, windows on the east and west side of the John Greer addition will be replaced at a cost of \$23,800.
