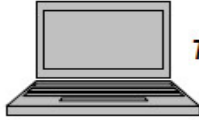

## Students' actions better with district behavioral program

Many Hoopeston Area students are behaving better, and that improvement is credited to a behavior program used in the district.

Ann Penicook, district coordinator for the Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports program, presented data to the Hoopeston Area school board Thursday night, showing that all schools are making progress with the program.

After success with behaviors such as tardiness and bad language, Penicook said more effort will now be spent on secondary and tertiary services. The district received a grant to work with Crosspoint Human

Services of Danville, providing counseling services to middle school students. Penicook hopes the grant can be expanded to cover more buildings in the district.

In other business, the board:

- Approved a \$19,798 bid from Better Paving for resurfacing the high/middle school parking lot.
- Approved continued membership in the Illinois Association of School Boards for \$3,551.
- Approved resignations of Christina Hott at the end of the 20-11-12 year and Richard Sollars at the end of the 201-2013 year.

Resignations of Brant Lochart, middle/high school choral/show choir director and Bridget Conn, part time cafeteria worker, were accepted for the end of this school year.

• Approved hiring Tricia Freeland, Maple second grade teacher; Thomas Sage, high school English teacher; and Kyle Snyders, John Greer Title 1 teacher.

• Approved calendar waivers for Veterans Day and Lincoln's birthday, which will be student attendance days, and Presidents' Day and Pulaski Day, when students will not attend.
