

A 12-year-old Danville run-away's odyssey to get home Monday started in Hoopeston and ended in tragedy near Westville.

Travis Messenger, 12, along with three siblings, were removed from their Danville home Monday by the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services. The boy was at Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital for a medical evaluation when he slipped away. Travis allegedly stole a pickup truck from a driveway in the 700 block of East Chestnut.

That theft was reported to police at 5:49 a.m. Monday.

Travis headed south on Route 1. When he turned onto 136, the truck struck the back of a vehicle stopped at the intersection, then continued westbound. He then turned around, heading east until he lost control of the truck and struck a pole and sign.

Witnesses said the only person in the truck, who appeared to be a 12-14-year-old boy, ran into a cornfield.

Travis allegedly got his second vehicle less than half a mile from the accident scene. A minivan was taken from a garage.

At some time, a 14-year-old friend, Logan Cudney, joined Travis and was with him during the second accident at 8:56 a.m. on County Road 1750 East, southeast of Westville. According to reports, Travis lost control of the minivan when the road changed from pavement to gravel. The van rolled at least once, and both boys were ejected from the vehicle.

Both children were taken to Carle Foundation Hospital, where Travis was pronounced dead at 6 p.m. Logan was listed in critical condition Wednesday.

Guardianship of Travis and three siblings, including a twin brother and two sisters, was given to DCFS on July 6. The boy was placed in an Urbana foster home earlier this month, running away after less than a week. He was then returned to DCFS custody and brought to Hoopes-
