## MainSource Bank makes up some cut funds for agency

A local financial institution is helping make up for a social service agency's funding cuts.

MainSource Bank of Hoopeston recently made a \$3,500 donation to Hoopeston Multi Agency to help offset some of its funding cuts.

The Multi Agency "is the only agency in the community that we have identified that does everything we would contribute to," said Tim George, local MainSource manager.

Money for the donation came from the MainSource's Community Reinvestment Act funds, he said.

Multi Agency director Chalmers Flint said the money may go towards several projects, including the emergency fund, building maintenance and van costs.

Like many other entities, the Multi Agency's funding from the state is late. Funding was cut from \$42,000 to \$22,000, and of that, the state is late with \$11,000, Flint said.
