Solis will speak to students at an assembly Thursday. On Friday, she will be at Hoopeston Public Library from 2-3 p.m. There, she will sign copies of *Aim High: Extraordinary Stories of Hispanic and Latina Women*. The book, written by Laura Contreras-Rowe, includes Solis' story.

At 7 p.m. Friday, "An Evening with Evelina" will be held at Hoopeston Area High School auditorium. The event, sponsored by New Beginnings Church, is free and open to all.

Solis' grandparents settled in Hoopeston to provide roots for their family. Solis, an excellent student, was involved in many extracurricular activities at Hoopeston Area. Her father's job transfer forced the family to move while she was in high school. However, a return to Hoopeston allowed her to complete her high school career at HAHS and serve as the senior
