Rossville residents celebrate opening of new medical clinic



ROSSVILLE—Scores of residents got a look at the village's new medical clinic Tuesday.

The new Rossville Medical Clinic, located near the Rossville fire Station, was officially unveiled at an open house Tuesday evening.

Dennis Price, physician's assistant for more than 30 years, was to begin seeing patients in the new office Wednesday, taking advantage of 3,000 sq. ft. of space, including waiting room, exam rooms, physician office and, new to Rossville, x-ray and lab services. Rural prescription drug delivery will be by Hudson Drugs, of Paxton. Cost of the clinic, including equipment, is \$800,000.

Price will be the primary provider of care at the clinic, along with Dr. Jay Colbert.

Residents expressed pleasure at the new clinic, commenting on the larger size of exam rooms, the décor and ample parking.
