## Hoopeston Area board makes suggestions on building plan

Hoopeston Area School Board is expected to vote November 17 on moving ahead with a new construction project.

The board met in special session Thursday with architect Mike Snedden of Upchurch & Associates of Champaign to review drawings for a new district office/transportation facility.

The project is estimated to cost \$650,500 and will include offices for the superintendent, business manager/transportation director and mechanic, as well as business office staff. The 4,400 sq. ft. structure will also include a conference room, general office space, break room and

an area for bus drivers.

Before the board's regular November meeting, Snedden will submit a new drawing, revamping the roof line from the current three lines to two, based on questions from board president Russ Walder.

Board member Chris Elliott asked Snedden drainage issues and about site work and whether the base under the building will be rock, saying rock from an area quarry is going to a wind farm project at Collison, so rock may have to be brought in from another quarry at higher cost.

Snedden said surveyors will mark the rise and fall of the land. The final plan will take those readings into account. As for the rock, Snedden said it is a small part of the total cost, so transporting it from a farther quarry would not be a large issue.

While school officials have considered a separate district office for several years, the thrust to do it now is to allow the school's ag program to use the current bus garage for its shop.

In unrelated business, the board held a public hearing prior to the special meeting for comment on a proposed PE waiver for juniors and seniors meeting certain criteria.

State-mandated criteria include participation in ROTC or band, need for a class to graduate or college prep class.

The board approved applying for the two-year waiver, which will be voted on by the state general assembly in the spring.

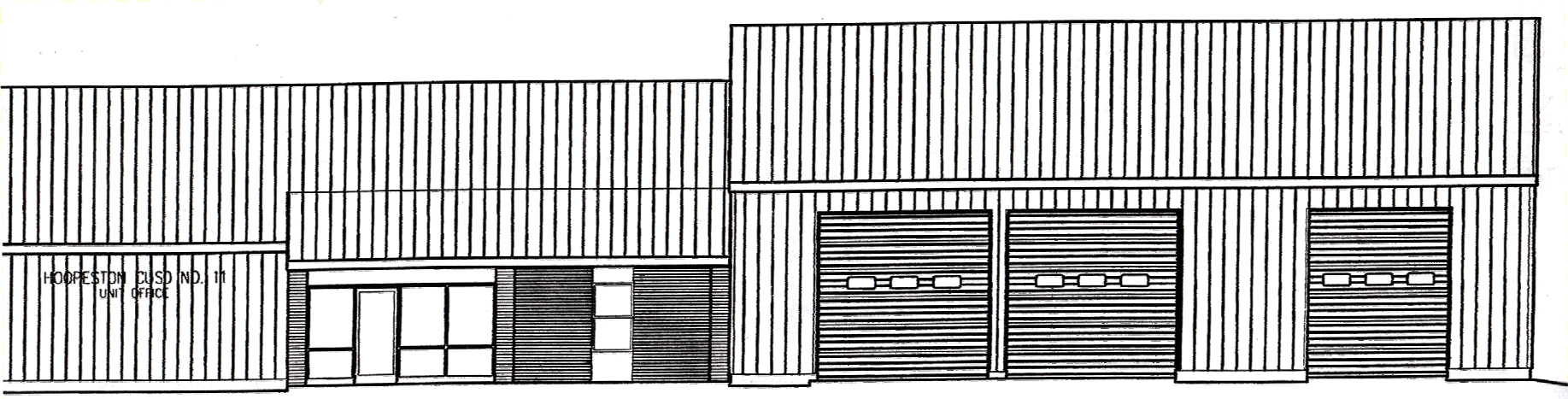
