

Hoopeston woman pleads guilty to financial exploitation

A Hoopeston woman pleaded guilty to two felonies concerning her caretaking of the elderly.

Pamela S. Pruitt, 43, was sentenced earlier this month after pleading guilty the financial exploitation of the elderely/disabled/\$5,000-\$10,000 and theft intent control \$10,000-\$100,000. Both are Class 2 felonies.

In return for her guilty plea, Pruitt was sentenced to 24 months' probation, restitution of \$11,138.27, to be repaid over five years and barred from caring for anyone over 60 years old under any circumstances.
