DACC Foundation scholarship applications now available

Applications are currently available to apply for nearly 300 scholarships offered by the Danville Area Community College Foundation for the 2012-2013 school year. Scholarship awards for 2011-2012 exceeded \$260,000.

The DACC Foundation Scholarship application allows applicants to complete one form to be considered for all Foundation scholarships. Traditional and non-traditional, part-time and full-time students who plan to attend DACC are eligible. First-time DACC students, recent high school graduates, adults, and current DACC students are encouraged to apply.
