Historians, writers to work on Danville basketball museum

Basketball historians from around the state are coming together in January to begin an unprecedented project: sharing and preserving the stories of Illinois basketball. The invited historians, sports writers and documentarians who have spent their lives watching men's and women's basketball at every level across the state will come together Monday, Jan. 2, 2012 at Red Bird Arena on the Illinois State University cam-

pus in Bloomington. Believed to be the first such even in Illinois sports history, the gathering will be an opportunity to begin putting together the history of Illinois basketball from grade school to the professionals.

The historians are being brought together by the Illinois Basketball Hall of Fame Museum in Danville. The meeting will be facilitated by Bruce Firchau, Illinois Basketball Coaches Association liaison to the museum. "We are excited to bring together all of these individuals who have spent much of their lives recording the history of basketball at every level in the state of Illinois," Firchau said. Historians will be asked to share their knowl-
