

Year in Review

Economic news leads top stories of area

Investment in the community by local businesses tops the list of stories for 2011.

At the forefront of the list is Hoopeston Regional Health Center's announcement of plans for a new nursing home on Route 1 across from Anthem Chevrolet. In February, USDA officials announced a \$6 million low-interest loan for the 75-bed nursing home.

Coming in second, and related to the nursing home, was Hoopeston officials application for and reception of a \$750,000 grant for a new water line from the Main Street water plant to the site of the new nursing home.

Earlier this month, the Hoopeston City Council approved Cross Construction's \$595,000 bid for the work, which will be done during the winter months. The water main project will benefit not only the nursing home, but also other businesses and residents on the city's north side.

Hoopeston Regional Health Center is back for the Number 3 spot with its announcement in March that Hoopeston Regional Hospital, as well as Charlotte Ann Russell Medical Center and clinics in Rossville and Cissna Park will join Carle Foundation in March 2012. The move is expected increase local residents' access to Carle's advanced technology and medical care.

The fourth place entry was 19 years in the making, as fugitive Dennis Catron was arrested in Thailand and returned to the United States.

The Top 10 of 2011

Catron was arrested in Hoopeston in 1991 after allegedly molesting a 13-year-old boy. He skipped bond, then turned himself in. After being released on bond a second time, Catron

was convicted in absentia of sexually abusing the boy and sentenced to 12 years. After his June 30 arrest in Bangkok, Catron flew to Los Angeles County, where he was erroneously released, then apprehended again, and was returned to Vermilion County on July 25.

Classified as a sexual predator, Catron is appealing his conviction.

Rounding out the top five is the announcement that after more than 30 years, Hoopeston would be the recipient of a new McDonald's restaurant.

Owners Don and Deanna Witzel announced the new store would be the first "street retail" model in Illi-



nois, featuring not only the McDonald's, but two spaces for other retail ventures.

The new McDonald's opened in October and tenant for one of the two spots in the building has been found. A developer is also looking for a tenant for the former restaurant.

The remaining top 10 entries include:

6. In January, Rossville-Alvin officials announced that a referendum would appear on the April ballot asking voters whether the board should be allowed to consider reactivating the high school, which was deactivated six years ago.

In April, voters gave their permission, approving the measure 353-296. Despite getting the green light, R-A officials continue to meet with representatives of both Hoopeston Area and Bismarck Henning, which have a tri-party agreement covering tuitioning R-A high school students to the other districts.

7. After much heated discussion and a rebidding, Rossville officials approved a new sewer line extending from Summit to Earl Court.

8. Local residents were notified in April that Rossville's ConAgra plant would close, cutting 170 jobs, including management. A majority of those jobs - 150 - were kept in the county when Full-Fill Indus-

tries, LLC, of Henning, announced it entered into an agreement with ConAgra Foods to produce the cooking sprays made at the Rossville plant.

9. Hoopeston officials learned in August that developers planned to build a 32-unit upscale assisted living complex on Route 9 near Casey's. Ground work has already started on the project, which is expected to be completed in 2012.

10. Hoopeston Area students provided much positive news this year. Currently, marching band students are in Memphis, Tenn., for their New Year's Day appearance at the Liberty Bowl. Earlier this year, Felipe Martinez took third place in IHSA wrestling finals and Lauren Houmes finished sixth at HISA cross country finals. And on the field, Hoopeston Area's football team won their first Homecoming game in recent memory, defeating Danville Schlarman 20-6.
