School district to court local contractors for construction

Every effort is being made to use local contractors for Hoopeston Area's district office/bus garage.

At Thursday evening's school board meeting, the group unanimously approved construction documents and authorized seeking bids on the project, with special emphasis given to local providers.

Mike Sneddon, with architectural firm Upchurch Group, said he had identified 35 possible providers with Hoopeston addresses. Letters will be sent to those firms, encouraging them to submit bids for contracting, subcontracting or supplies. General contracting bids will also be sought outside Hoopeston, he said.

In other business, the board is reviewing a new Tri Party Deactivation Agreement, which is also under review by Rossville-Alvin and Bismarck-Henning boards.

The agreement covers Rossville-Alvin's high school students, who attend either Hoopeston Area or Bismarck-Henning, following R-A's 2005 deactivation of the high school.

The one year contract has a few changes, Superintendent Hank Hornbeck told the board. The first is that parents and students will have until March 1 to choose which high school their students will attend. That is later than the January 15 date that has been in effect.

Board member Chris Elliott said Rossville-Alvin officials requested the change, allowing RA parents to get through the Christmas break without stressing about a decision.

The new agreement also changes how much Hoopeston Area and Bismarck-Henning will receive in tuition for RA students.

Next year, each district will receive 95 percent of its tuition rate, based on the fiscal year 2012 audit. This is a change from 100 percent of the combined average of Hoopeston and Bismarck rates, Hornbeck said.

The contract is valid from July 1, 2012 to June 20, 2013 and will automatically renew unless any of the parties provides written notice of nonrenewal by January 1, 2013, according to the agreement.

In 2011, Rossville voters approved allowing the school board to look into reactivating the high school, estimated to cost about \$1 million. The Rossville-Alvin board has not taken any action towards reactivation.
