Legislators pan Quinn's state of the state address

Gov. Pat Quinn's plans for the state, outlined in Wednesday's State of the State address, are receiving tepid reviews from local legislators.

Reviewing the three years since he took office, Quinn told his audience that Illinois was "off course and adrift, lacking leadership, and weighed down by a culture of corruption. On the day I became Governor...I promised to restore integrity to Illinois government. And we have."

Quinn touted new ethics laws, campaign finance reform, the ability to recall a governor, legalizing civil unions, raising nursing home standards, abolishing the

death penalty, export growth, the largest public works construction program in state history and "solid gains" in education as things that make Illinois a better state.

Looking to the future, Quinn said Medicaid and public pension programs must be reformed in the coming year, and pushed modest tax relief, more college grant spending and ending the state's natural gas tax, but offered few details on how to accomplish those goals.

His remarks got no support from local legislators.

As with previous "State of the State" addresses, expectations were low and were certainly met by Governor Pat Quinn, according to State Sen. Shane Cultra (R-Onarga).

"The Governor needs to get serious," Cultra said. "With the exception of the discussion on policies for veterans, Quinn's speech falls on deaf ears. We needed more substance and direction from the state's Chief Executive. Quinn keeps floating plans then retracting them under media pressure. Will he ever get serious and legitimately lead, I am not very optimistic."

Rep. Jason Barickman (R-Champaign) was a little kinder in his response. "I am pleased to see that the Governor has finally come to the realization that our top

"The Governor showed total disregard for the problems facing our state. Illinois has a backlog of unpaid bills that reaches eight billion dollars and the largest deficit in the country. The Governor did not even discuss these issues, let alone lay out his plans to address them. Most of today's address discussed new programs and new spending as the best path toward economic

growth. The Governor could have shown leadership on these issues, but instead he chose to ignore them."
