John Greer, middle school named 2011 Spotlight Schools

Two Hoopeston Area schools have been named Illinois Spotlight Schools for 2011. John Greer and Hoopeston Area Middle School received the honor last month. They are two of 167 schools earning the honor this year. The award recognizes high-poverty schools "where academic performance is closing the achievement gap," according to a congratulatory letter from Christopher A. Koch, state superintendent of education.



- Criteria for the award include:
- At least half of enrolled students are classified as low-income in 2011
 - Schools must have made Adequate Yearly Progress

for the last two years, 2010 and 2011, as required by No Child Left Behind. Under 2011 requirements, 85 percent of students had to meet or exceed standards.

- At least 60 percent of students must have met or exceeded standards in both reading and mathematics in 2011, and at least 50 percent of students met or exceeded the standards in 2009 and 2010.

According to the program's website, John Greer had a poverty rate of 66.2 percent of students, while HAMS' rate was 61 percent.


