Cultra introduces 'Drano' repeal

ONARGA-Following up on a January promise to constituents, State Sen. Shane Cultra (R-Onarga) introduced legislation to seek a repeal of the unpopular "Drano" bill.

"It is regretful that the initial 'Drano' bill passed through the General Assembly," Cultra said. "While legislators are sensitive to the tragic acid attacks that occurred in Chicago, it is necessary to respond with a sensible solution that does not impact commerce or the average consumer too harshly."

Senate Bill 3343 would simply repeal Public Act 97-565, requiring commercial vendors to ask customers for photo identification and log the purchases of caustic substances. Retailers have found the act erroneous and over burdensome.

"The sponsors had honest and well-intentioned motivation for the legislation that passed, but the paperwork nightmare that was created for stores is simply out of bounds," said Cultra, who, along with all legislators, voted for the "Drano" bill.

SB 3343 was introduced on Feb. 7 and awaits committee assignment.
