Deadline February 29 for DACC scholarship applications

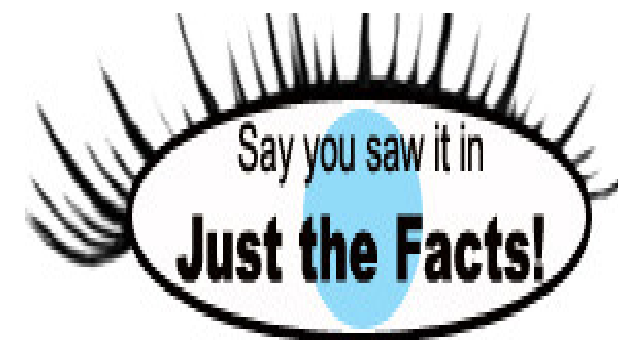
