New business just open already giving back to community

It's normal for local businesses to give back the communities they serve.

It's rarer for a business to give back when they haven't yet received much from a community.

But Hoopeston's newest business, Robinson Chiropractic of Hoopeston, is doing just that.

Graduating from Bloomington High School in 1984, he attended Elmhurst College, graduating with honors with a degree in computer science and a minor in mathematics. Following graduation, he spent 17 years at State Farm Insurance in Bloomington, during which time, he developed an interest in bodybuilding.

It was during this time that Smart developed a passion for health and nutrition. He left State Farm in 2004 to attend Logan College of Chiropractic in Chesterfield, Mo. While there, he received a second

bachelor's degree in life science in 2006. He received his Doctor of Chiropractic degree in 2008, graduating summa cum laude and as valedictorian from Logan. He also received certification in chiropractic pediatrics from Logan and an internal health specialist certificate from Loomis Institute of Enzyme Nutrition.
