Local author to sign new novel at Hoopeston Public Library

Sports have often been used as a backdrop for stories of life and family relationships. The Midwestern passion for high school basketball provides that central focus for the exploration of more serious issues in "Transcendental Basketball Blues," a just-released novel by Hoopeston resident Mike Pemberton.

Pemberton will speak and sign copies of his new book at 10 a.m. Saturday, March 3, at Hoopeston Public Library, 110 N. Fourth Street.

Set in the late 1970s in basketball-crazy Illinois, the book brings to life the post-Vietnam days when racial integration took tentative first steps, stagflation sim-

mered, disco fever raged and Top 40 radio ruled. The novel centers around teenager Jack Henderson, a star basketball player, and his relationship with his talented, troubled mother who suffers from paranoid schizophrenia. Pemberton said the story is "ultimately about finding one's passions, the ability to laugh in the face of despair, the strength of family, love and forgiveness."

A Normal native, Pemberton lived in Chicago and Dallas before moving to Hoopeston with his family 15 years ago. He holds bachelor's and master's degrees in English and is a former sportswriter and columnist for the Bloomington Pantagraph.
