### HEALTHCARE EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY SPONSORED BY DACC C.N.A. PROGRAM

Danville Area Community College [DACC], in partnership with Hoopeston Community Memorial Nursing Home, will host a C.N.A. class at the Hoopeston Nursing Home campus. The class runs from May 30, 2012 through August 3, 2012. Attendance is required at all class sessions.

Prior to acceptance into the training program, applicants will be tested in Hoopeston by DACC adult education staff. In addition, applicants must complete an electronic fingerprint scan on the DACC campus. Applicants must live in the DACC school district to qualify for tuition waivers. There is an estimated cost to all students of \$130-\$150 in uniforms, books and fees.

sponsored by the specific group.


We will also have The Great American Clean-up Day again this year, on May 5, so keep that in mind, we will need lots of help to make it the success that it was last year.


