Three Hoopeston people injured with sword, baseball bat

Three people received medical treatment after a Hoopeston man allegedly wielding a samurai sword and a Hoopeston woman allegedly wielding a bat, injured them.

Police were called at 4:01 a.m. Sunday to the 500 block of West Main for a report of a man attacking people with a samurai sword. Police arrived to find one victim in the street with what was described as severe lacerations to his arm.

That man, 25, of Hoopeston, was taken to Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, for treatment. His condition was not available at press time.

Two other Hoopeston men, ages 22 and 23, were treated and released from Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital.

Police charged Kurt A. Pecsenye, 22, of Hoopeston, and Sarah N. Warren, 22, also of Hoopeston, with aggravated battery with a deadly weapon.

Pecsenye was also charged with domestic battery from an earlier incident involving a 20-year-old Hoopeston man, who alleged Pecsenye knocked him to the ground and choked him during an altercation in the 500 block of West Main.
