In other business, a plan to buy two 71-passenger buses was scrapped after Illinois officials decided to keep a larger part of the corporate personal property tax to pay off state debts.

Hoopeston Area expects to receive \$217,000 less next year than this, said business/transportation director Mark Eighner, saying the decision to not purchase buses is "probably the right thing to do at this point."

After the meeting, Superintendent Hank Hornbeck said the district uses its share of the corporate personal
