

Jennifer Fourez, who has hemophagocytic lymphohistiocytosis (HLS), recently underwent a bone marrow transplant at the Children's Hospital in St. Louis and is recovering from the procedure there.

From her hospital room, Jennifer was able to watch her classmates graduate via Skype and her pre-recorded valedictorian speech was played

during Friday night's graduation ceremony.

Jennifer shared valedictorian honors with Maya Clemmons, Lauren Houmes, Corey Rudin and Erika Samet.

Jennifer was diagnosed with HLH in November, after experiencing intense fatigue, severe joint pain, rashes and fever since last spring.

She has been unable to attend school since November but has continued with school work through tutoring.


