## City contributes to local community college satellite office

Hoopeston officials unanimously approved giving \$30,000 of Tax Increment Financing towards a proposed Danville Area Community College site in Hoopeston and another \$30,000 to Hoopeston Area High School for its new administrative/bus maintenance building.

In recommending the donations Tuesday night, Alderman Bill Goodwine, finance committee chairman, said school Superintendent Hank Hornbeck asked the council last November for \$60,000. The request was delayed because the city had already donated TIF funds and since then, Hornbeck told Goodwine he would settle for

half the amount if the other half could go to the DACC project.

DACC president Alice Jacobs attended the council meeting and thanked the city, along with Hoopeston Regional Health Center, Hornbeck and Bill Nicholls for their assistance with the satellite project.

DACC will use Hoopeston Regional Health Center's business office, which will need \$150,000 of renovations and another \$71,000 in equipment, along with \$86,000 in operational costs, Jacobs said.

Last month, the city approved a \$30,000 grant from the revolving loan program for the satellite campus.


