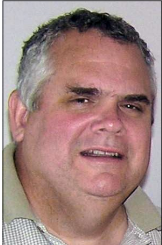
Hoopeston Area sets '12-13 registration times, dates

Hoopeston Area school district has announced registration times and dates for the 2012-13 school year. Registration will begin Tuesday, Aug. 7, with middle/high school registration from 8:30-11 a.m. and 12:30-

3:30 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 8, students in grades ECSE, K-6 (Maple, Honeywell and John Greer) may register from 1-6 p.m. at Hoopeston Area Middle School. Also, registration assistance will be available for migrant families. Look for the Migrant Education table. Registration will conclude Thursday, Aug. 9, with high school students registering from 8:30-11 a.m. and 12:30-3:30 p.m. Freshman orientation will also be held on Thursday, at 6 p.m. in the high school auditorium. 'Cornjerkers' author to speak

The fall of 1967 was a time of new beginnings and a time for questioning. Television was filled with the horrors of the Vietnam War, political upheaval and campus protesters.

"Cornjerkers" by Dave Theobald, is the saga of Hoopeston's class of 1968, a story of best friends and old time family values still alive in the midst of that tumultuous decade.

Theobald, a former Hoopeston resident and '68 Hoopeston High School graduate, will share about his new book at 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. Saturday, July 14, at Hoopeston Public Library.

"Cornjerkers" represents Baby Boomers who struggled through those turbulent times. According to the publisher, it is neither wholly fictional nor, strictly speaking, a memoir. Rather, "Cornjerkers" is a blend of fantasy, adolescent memories, folklore and history.

"Living in Hoopeston Illinois and being surrounded by such good friends gave me a sense of belonging and a sense of security and freedom that could not be found in larger communities," Theobald said. "Hoopeston in the 1960s always gave the feeling that the entire town was one big family that watched out for each other. It was just one of those great places to live.

and \$50 for students in grades K-12. Additionally, the middle and high schools have a \$20 per activity fee with a maximum of \$40 per student and \$80 per family.

High school activity fees, due at registration, include:

- \$50 for all ninth graders for driver's ed.
- Spanish I, II and III, \$20 for a workbook
- Government students \$12 for a weekly magazine
- Accounting I and II, \$12 for a workbook.

State requirements are that all kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade students must have health physicals before the start of school for students, which is August 20, 2012.

Students involved in sports will be required to have a sports physical to be able to participate in sports for the 2012-2013 school year.
