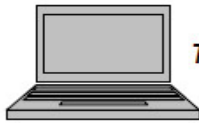

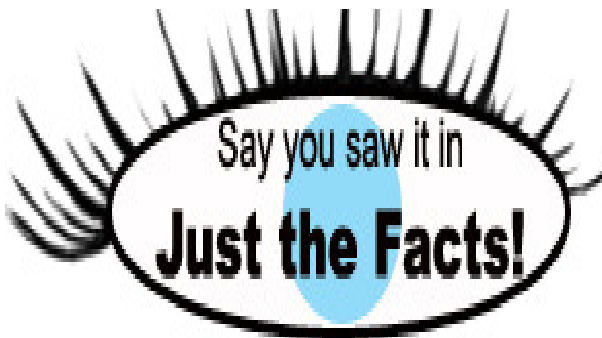

If any child missed registration, the family may apply for school supplies after August 16.
