## Hoopeston Area registration going on Tuesday-Thursday

Hoopeston Area school district has announced registration times and dates for the 2012-13 school year.

Registration will begin

a maximum of \$40 per student and \$80 per family. High school activity fees, due at registration, include:

Tuesday, Aug. 7, with midmust do to play 2012-13 sports

> Hoopeston Area athletic trainer Elissa Hooper has compiled a list of things student athletes must do before starting fall practice. The list includes:

- •Sports Physical: 10-12<sup>th</sup> grades- filled out completely and signed by parent and student
- •Full School Physical: Ninth graders-filled out completely and signed by parent and student
- •Athletic Permit Card, filled out completely and signed by parent and student
- IHSA Performance Enhancement agreement sheet
- •ImPACT baseline test- 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade athletes Soccer, Football, Basketball, Wrestling)
- •IHSA Concussion Awareness Sheet: will be handed out at parent meeting or first day of practice. Must be turned in by August 10, 2012

All forms may be picked up and returned to the athletic trainer's office (located in the high school weight room).

• \$50 for all ninth graders for driver's ed.

- Spanish I, II and III, \$20 for a workbook
- Government students \$12 for a weekly magazine
- Accounting I and II, \$12 for a workbook.

State requirements are that all kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade students must have health physicals before the start of school for students, which is August 20, 2012.

Students involved in sports will be required to have a sports physical to be able to participate in sports for the 2012-2013 school


