of the probably 20 years it has been in effect. Under the no-frills program, someone who needs glasses or a hearing aid presents financial information. If accepted, the person then goes to the Hoopeston Chittick Family Eye Care office or the Beltone office in Danville, for glasses or hearing aids, respectively. The club pays for close to 400 pairs of glasses for adults and children each year. Participants are able to receive an eye exam and choose from select frames. Leigh said costs average \$150 per adult and \$100 per child for those who don't need an update prescription, which increases the cost.

Participants may receive one pair of glasses every two years. Children may receive new frames as they grow, but adults reuse frames for new lenses.

The club does fewer hearing aids—usually one or two per year. The cost of each hearing aid is higher but Leigh said Beltone provides a large discount. Additionally, the club collects used hearing aids and gives them to Beltone where they are remolded into new aids, saving more money.

Funding for the program comes from annual Candy Day sales but because of the economy, requests are increasing, Leigh said. "I'm hoping for a good Candy Day," he said.

The Lions also accept tax-deductible donations for the program, which may be sent to Hoopeston Lions Club, P.O. Box 267, Hoopeston IL 60942.
