Paranormal activity in Rossville to be subject of new film

ROSSVILLE—Alleged paranormal activity at Rossville's former opera house will be the subject of an upcoming film.

Dave Triska, of Lafayette, Ind., owner of The Haunted Opera House, attended Monday night's village board meeting to talk about the project.

A psychic medium is expected to be at the opera house/former Masonic temple on September 8, as are paranormal film producer Dan Hall and film crew. "When people hear there's a Dan Hall movie, they'll be coming out of the woodwork to see it," Triska said.

A second event is being arranged for November,

when Chicago psychic reader Edward Shanahan may be at the opera house, Triska said. The events have "a lot of potential for the opera house and potential for Rossville," he said.

Triska, part of National Ghost Hunters, said when he first toured the opera house prior to purchasing it, "the activity going in blew us away."

Resident Caroline Barragree wife of trustee Dennis Barragree, said she and her husband lived in the opera house in the early days of their marriage and noticed no paranormal activity. Citing her Christian beliefs, Barragree said she is opposed to the project. "I don't think that's what we want to be known for," she said. "From my standpoint of wanting to honor God, I don't think a psychic honors God."

Following the meeting, Barragree and Judy Rayfield continued to discuss the project with Triska.

In other business, trustees approved a new employee insurance contract with Health Alliance through Crose Insurance of Danville.

The plan will cost \$18,960, up one percent from last year, Crose told the board. The plan differs from the existing Health Alliance coverage in several ways that
