## Hoopeston, other communities in need of election judges

Vermilion County election authorities are looking for election judges for November 6.

County Clerk Lynn Foster said 24 Republican judges are needed in the county, with Oakwood and Hoopeston needing the most. Other vacancies are in Blount township, Tilton, Ridge Farm, Jamaica township, McKendree Township, Oakwood, Fithian, Rossville, Henning, Allerton and Fairmount, Foster said.

Democrats are faring somewhat better but alternates and standbys are still needed in almost all areas of the county.

Typically, the two political parties and their committee

people supply the required number of judges, but this obligation has been met less and less in recent years, relying instead on outreach efforts by local election officials to fill the void.

"Election judges are crucial to providing fair elections and protecting the rights of voters," Foster said. "They are the 'front line' of democracy on election day.

"The pay is between \$100-\$120 but the satisfaction is immense."
