Residents to polls Tuesday for local, state, national voting

Heavy turnout is expected Tuesday as voters across the country choose the next president.

Vermilion County ballots have GRANT 1 four choices for the top office: GRANT 2 Republican challenger Mitt GRANT 3 Romney and running mate Paul Ryan; incumbent Democrat Barack Obama and vicepresident Joe Biden; Libertarian Party candidate Gary Johnson and running mate James P. Gray: and Green Party candidate Jil Stein and running mate Howie Hawkins.

In the 15th U.S. Congressional district, formerly served by Tim Johnson, John M. Shimkus hopes to hold the seat for Republicans against Democrat candidate Angela Michael.

At the state level, Republican Jason Barickman is running unopposed for state senator of the 53rd district and Josh Harms, Republican, is running unopposed for the 106th representative district.

At the county level, District 1 representatives to the Vermilion County Board - Republicans Gary Weinard, Chris Leigh and Todd Johnson - are running unopposed.

The only contested county race is that of recorder, where both GOP candidate Thomas M. O'Shaughnessy and Democrat Nikki Bogart each hope to win the seat.

Judicial retention questions are also on the ballot, including Rita B. Garman of the Illinois Supreme Court; John Turner of the Appellate Court; and fifth judicial circuit judges Craig DeArmond and Nancy Fahey.

Statewide, voters will be asked whether the Illinois Constitution should be amended to require a three-fifths

> majority vote to increase any public pension benefits. The ballot does not include text of the proposed amendment, which was mailed to state residents earlier this year.

> At the county level, voters will be asked to decide two propositions. The first asks if the county be authorized to sell the county nursing home, Vermillion Manor. The second asks if the county shall have the authority to arrange for the supply of electricity for its residential and small commercial retail customers who have not opted out of such a program.
