Nursing home, electric referenda pass handily in county

Vermilion County officials now have the authority to sell Vermilion Manor Nursing Home and aggregate electricity for county residents.

In results from Tuesday's election, 17,873 resident voted to give the county authority to sell the nursing home, while 10,693 voted against it.

The unofficial results include both Vermilion County and City of Danville.

As for allowing the county to purchase electricity at a cheaper rate than that available from Ameren, 16,227 voter approved, with 11,780 against.

Both issues passed in all six Grant precincts although

five of the six, more voters cast ballots on the nursing home issue than electricity.

In other election results, none of incumbent District 1 candidates to the County Board (Gary Weinard, Chris Leigh and Todd Johnson) faced challengers.

In the only real race, GOP Thomas O'Shaughnessy bested Democrat challenger Nikki Bogart in the race for Recorder.

In unofficial umbers, O'Shaughnessy received 11,430 votes in the county and 4,552 in Danville, for a total of 15,982 while Bogart took Danville with 5,651 but was down in the county with 7,438 for a total of 13,089.
