Social security offices to have shortened hours for public

Effective November 19, 2012, Illinois Social Security offices will be open to the public Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – a reduction of 30 minutes each weekday. In addition, beginning January 2, 2013, offices will close to the public at noon every Wednesday.

While agency employees will work their regular hours, shorter public hours will allow them to complete interviews and process claims work without overtime. Reduced funding provided by Congress under the continuing

resolution for the first six months of the fiscal year makes it impossible for the agency to provide overtime.

On November 23, all Social Security field offices will be closed to the public. Employees working that day will focus on reducing backlogged workloads.

Most Social Security services, including applying for retirement, disability or Medicare benefits, signing up for direct deposit, replacing a Medicare card, obtaining a proof of income letter or informing us of a change of address or telephone number are conveniently available at www.socialsecurity.gov or at 1-800-772-1213.
