Company investigates break


A Chicago firm is investigating why one of its wind turbine blades broke last week.

Invenergy LLC issued a statement last week about the

Tuesday break of a turbine in the recently erected California Ridge Wind Farm on Route 49, north of 2700 North Road.

"As designed, the turbine automatically ceased operation and no one was injured in the incident," the statement said.

"As a company that prides itself on the safe operations of our wind farms across the country, we will determine exactly what occurred in this particular situation," the statement continued.



214 megawatt wind

farm built this year in Vermilion and Champaign counties. It includes property north of Royal and south of Penfield in Champaign County and in Vermilion County, spans north of Oakwood and South of Potomac. Vermilion County has 104 of the wind farm's 134 total turbines.

According to printed reports, this is the second turbine blade break in central Illinois this year. A turbine blade at Settlers Trail wind farm near Sheldon broke in June. That project is owned by E.On Climate & Renewables, also based in Chicago.
