# Hoopeston Area High School receives PBIS recognition

Hoopeston Area High School's PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) program is getting noticed at the state level.

School officials were recently notified that the program will be featured in a state PBIS publication. The draft of information states:


"Teaching Social Behavior in

High School Creates Positive Student Outcomes

Hoopeston Area High School in Hoopeston Area CUSD 11 continues to see a decrease in office discipline referrals (ODRs), out of school suspensions (OSS), and tardies. This school is in its fifth full year of implementation and recently renewed efforts to teach behavioral expectations effectively. As a result, ODRs have decreased 22% (748 to 585) for August through November of 2012 compared to the same period in 2011. Additionally, OSS have reduced 38% during the same interval and tardies are down 9%. Teachers attribute this improvement to daily teaching of expectations and students' high exposure to PBIS. The same behavioral expectations are used district-wide from kindergarten through high school."

School officials credit community and parent support in achieving the progress.
