Police, school officials respond to alleged threat on social media

Hoopeston police and Hoopeston Area school officials have investigated a report that a high school student planned to bring a gun to school Thursday.

Parents and police monitoring social networking sites Wednesday found "chatter" about the student coming to school with a gun, according to a joint press release from Chief Mark Drollinger and Superintendent Hank Hornbeck.

The student and his parents were cooperative in the investigation. Officers searched the student and his home and found nothing that would confirm rumors on Facebook. Twitter and emails, the release said.

Hoopeston man charged in damage, burglary incidents

A 23-year-old Hoopeston man was arrested Wednesday on two incidents of burglary to vehicle and three reports of criminal damage to property.

Thomas J. Wray was arrested in the 200 block of East Main taken to the Public Safety building in Danville.

Wray was charged with burglary to vehicle in connection with an incident reported at 3:10 p.m. Wednesday, when a 25-year-old Hoopeston man alleged he was seen entering a vehicle at Market Street Auction, 109 N. Market, and a report at 3:15 p.m. from a Wellington woman who alleged Wray entered a vehicle outside Pizza King, 111 E. Main, then ran off.

Additionally, he was charged criminal damage to property for allegedly damaging an air conditioning unit and dishwasher at China Wok, 113 E. Main; an air conditioning unit at Pizza King; and a January 28 report of damage to an air conditioning unit at Hoopeston Coin Laundry, 209 S. First Ave.

Police determined that no threat was made electronically. To assure parents and students of their safety, there was police presence at the high school Thursday morning.

"This was a proactive, rather than a reactive, incident," said Drollinger in the written statement. "It appears no one was in danger at any time. The Hoopeston Police Department and Hoopeston Area High School's top priority is insuring the safety of its citizens and students."


