

#### State rep finds initial session disheartening

Anxious to get to work on legislation, I returned to Springfield last week for what was supposed to be a two day session designed to adopt the House rules, committee assignments and begin our work on the State's most pressing issues.

What occurred was a stunning lack of respect to the millions of constituents throughout the state of Illinois. The second day of session was cancelled and the House rules were only further stacked in favor of the few Chicago Democrats who hold all the power in the State of Illinois.

The House adopted a set of rules for the next two years that eliminate the requirement that all filed legislation be heard by a standing committee; allowing the Democrat majority to bottle up any legislation they don't see fit to advance. This is in conjunction with a reduced posting requirement allowing for less preparation and debate on major controversial legislation.

Aside from these rule changes, the House has too many

important and time sensitive issues that it must face for us to be cancelling session.

Yet another major credit agency, Standard and Poor's, downgraded our credit status to the lowest state in the nation; the effects of which were immediately felt in the forced postponement of a \$500 million bond sale. We have a clock ticking as directed by the Seventh Court of Appeals, which has handed Illinois the directive of crafting a Concealed Carry law that adheres to the Second Amendment.
